31 FEEDBACK ON SAFER ROUTES TO SCHOOLS MEETING WITH BCBC

Councillor A Davies, Chair of the Community Access Plan Committee, gave some feedback on the meeting held at BCBC. Councillor Davies explained the two plans of works which were presented 1 for the path behind Litchard School and an enhanced path into the school and the other an extended path from the steps into Litchard playing fields up to the play area and across to join up with the existing path. Both were different to the works identified in the bid submitted by the Community Council to BCBC. Members asked questions and suggested ways forward.

It was agreed that Councillors Williams and Davies would attend the meeting, along with the Clerk.
- Circulate the Community Access Plan and the Safer Routes document to all Councillors so that they could consider their priorities and this would be discussed as an agenda item at the July Ordinary Meeting.
