- Further observations are needed on the poor condition of the path to Pendre Community Centre
- Cllr Williams to familiarise himself with Penyrallt Avenue and the streets to the east of Bryn Llidiard
- Cllr Williams to update the plan by the November Ordinary Council meeting.
