51/25-26 TO DISCUSS A FUNDING OFFER AND RESOLVE ITS PROGRESS

Following a grant funding application to the Welsh Government Allotment Support Grant Scheme, Coity Higher CC has been successful in being awarded £10,630 towards the construction of footpaths around the newly created allotment garden at Coety Primary School.

As a previous council resolution was to apply for the funding, but to consider whether to go ahead with the project when the outcome was known, this meeting has been called in order to resolve:

- To go ahead/not go ahead with the project.
- To award the successful contractor the work. (3 quotes had been obtained)
- To review the budget and agree how the balance for the works will be funded.

All of the above were discussed and resolved.

Resolved: It was unanimously resolved to go ahead with the project, to award the contract to SW Contractors and to use the community projects budget line to fund the difference between the grant funding and the full cost. The Clerk would contact the school to let them know the outcome of the funding application, to find

out if any permissions were needed from BCBC or if all were in place and to engage the services of the contractor to carry out the work asap.
